ORDER OF DISMISSAL OF ALL CHARGES

COMES NOW the State of Kansas, through Assistant Attorneys General Richard G. Guinn and Barry K. Disney, and dismisses all charges in the above-captioned matter without prejudice.


The State of Kansas represents that this dismissal is not a delay tactic merely for the purpose of obtaining a continuance of the trial to a later more convenient or advantageous date. Although this dismissal is without prejudice, it is the contemplation of all parties that this dismissal will be final unless the state should discover evidence it believes materially strengthens its case against the defendants. With that understanding, the defendants Chad Floyd and Shannon Floyd do not object to dismissal without prejudice. By not objecting to dismissal without prejudice, the defendants do not otherwise intend to waive any factual or legal defenses they may have to any future charges, except that the defendants waive any statutory and/or speedy trial rights based upon this dismissal.

The State of Kansas agrees that all conditions of the defendants' appearance bonds have been satisfied, and the Court hereby exonerates the obligors, releases them from liability, and directs the clerk of the court to release any sureties, collateral, or other property securing the bond.


